Introductory text:

Our pediatric intestinal rehabilitation team at Karolinska cares for 25-30 home PN-patients living in Stockholm with surroundings. Annually, we see 7000 patients at our out-patient clinics and admit 450 patients at our in-patient wards at Astrid Lindgren's Childrens Hospital @ Karolinska in Huddinge and Solna. Our team consists of paediatric surgeons, gastroenterologists, specialised nurses, dieticians, speech therapists, psychologists and social workers. We work closely with the hospital pharmacy to individualize the parenteral nutrition, when necessary.

The gastroenterology unit at Karolinska follows 80-100 patients with intestinal failure type 2-3. Our team consists of surgeons, gastroenterologists, specialised nurses, dieticians, psychiatrist and social workers. We have access to Gastroenterology laboratory "GastroLab" for complete examination of GI function (manometries, satiety drinking test, motility capsulse, etc.) as well as for implantation of different types nutritional catheters. We have outpatient clinics with DH both at out hospital in Solna and in Huddinge. We have inpatient clinic at Solna hospital. We have close collaboration with transplantation team at University Hospital in Gothenburg.
