Department of treatment for children: Pediatric intestinal failure team, Department of Pediatric Surgery & Pediatric Gastroenterology

Introductory text:

The multidisciplinary paediatric intestinal failure (IF) team of the Sophia Children's Hospital in Rotterdam takes care of approximately 25 children on long-term home parenteral nutrition (PN). We serve as the referral centre for the southwest region of The Netherlands. We provide home PN training for parents of children newly diagnosed with IF and we monitor children on home PN at our outpatient clinic. The first contact in case of questions/problems is the nurse practitioner.
