## Introductory text:

Our center is one of the 6 pediatric authorized centers in France for home parenteral nutrition. We are a multidisciplinary team of pediatric and adult GI, pediatric surgeons, pharmacists, anesthesiologists, coordination nurses, dieticians, speech therapist and psychologists devoted to intestinal rehabilitation and prolonged parenteral nutrition. We are localized in a large tertiary pediatric center in the North of France (dealing with more than 4.5 million inhabitants), have a 20 beds hospitalization devoted to gastroenterology hepatology and nutrition diseases, and a home parenteral nutrition program (both for adults and children). We have every day 35-40 children at home with parenteral nutrition (and 200 adults).
